#### CQ MAGAZINE'S "DX MARATHON" CONTEST WORTH A SHOT

At the W9DXCC Convention, held just outside of Chicago on September 14, John Sweeney, K9EL, gave a presentation about the DX Marathon Contest, sponsored by CQ Magazine, that he oversees. To quote from the Contest's web site, "Starting January 1 of each year, the DX Marathon is the perfect answer for the DX-er who needs that extra incentive to get on the air every day! Simply work as many countries and CQ Zones as you can in each calendar year, regardless of the band or mode. Each country and zone counts only once, so you can concentrate on working new ones rather than working the same ones on multiple bands and modes. Confirmations are NOT required to participate. Many awards are given for the top overall scores in four classes plus top scores in modes, bands, US call areas and more!"

The overall premise of the contest is very simple, and it runs all year, so there is no staying up for a whole weekend to work a contest. You can operate casually and do
